NOTICE OF EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR THE PROVISION OF CONSULTANCY SERVICES FOR SUPERVISION OF DESIGN AND BUILD WORKS CONTRACTS FOR AQUACULTURE PARKS IN KALANGALA AND APAC DISTRICTS

The Government of Uganda received a grant with financial assistance from the EUROPEAN UNION funded Support to Promoting Commercial Aquaculture project in Uganda – FED/UG/038-334.

The Ministry of Agriculture Animal Industry & Fisheries (MAAIF) is the project's supervisor/ implementor.

The Overall objective of the project is to contribute to a competitive, profitable, job-intensive, environmentally-sustainable and climate-resilient agriculture sector in Uganda that also contributes to climate change adaptation.

The project aims to achieve the following results:

Result 1. A sound policy and regulatory framework is developed and effectively enforced;

Result 2. Production and productivity of aquaculture fish and fish products is enhanced;

Result 3. Post-harvest losses are reduced and marketing opportunities for aquaculture fish and fish products created.

Under result two, one of the key actions of the project is to develop two intensive aquaculture production systems (Aqua

parks): Land based (ponds system) in Taragoli, Apac district and water based- (cage system) in Mwena, Kalangala district.

The objective of the assignment is to carry out preliminary design review, supervision and monitoring of the physical progress, quality and the financial status of the design and construction works so as to ensure works completed on time, meet the engineering specifications, social, environmental standards. The services are expected to be completed within calendar months from the commencement date

To this aim, the National Authorising Officer (NAO) –EDF, Ministry of Finance, Planning and Economic Development (MoFPED) of Uganda/the Permanent Secretary/ Secretary to the Treasury, invites natural and legal persons to indicate their interest in providing the following consultancy services

- vi. Proven experience in management of design and build contracts is an added advantage
- vii. Detailed curriculum vitae showing assignments achieved; and
